You do not turn your face from us, nor cast us aside.

We confess that we have sinned against you and our neighbour.

We have wounded your love and spoiled your image in us.

**Restore us for the sake of your Son, and bring us to heavenly joy,
in Jesus Christ our Lord.**

Amen.

May the God of love bring *us* back to himself, forgive *us* our sins, and assure *us* of his eternal love in Jesus Christ our Lord.

CREED

We stand to declare our belief in God, who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit, using one of the following statements of faith.

We believe in God the Son, who lives in our hearts through faith, and fills us with his love.

We believe in God, the Holy Spirit, who strengthens us with power from on high.

We believe in one God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Amen.

We believe in God who created the world at the beginning of time.

We believe in God who came to this world to bring us new life.

We believe in God the Spirit who renews our life in God every day.

We believe in God who will come to make his home with us, forever.

Amen.

We may sit or kneel as we pray for others.

One of the following responses, or an alternative, may be used.

Lord, hear us,
Lord, graciously hear us.

And at the end:

Merciful Father,

our Saviour Jesus Christ.
Amen.**

We stand and the Peace is introduced with a suitable sentence, followed by,

The peace of the Lord be always with you.
and also with you.

Let us offer one another a sign of peace.

We may exchange a sign of peace, by shaking hands with one another, or by using sign language, and saying 'Peace be with you.'

We stand and, during the hymn or song, a collection will be taken for the work of the Church.

May the Father's hand keep you from stumbling,
the footprints of Jesus give you confidence to follow,
and the fire of the Spirit keep you warm and safe;
and the blessing of God almighty, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit
